



HOW TO MAKE A PHONE CALL

Making a phone call can be confusing, especially for newcomers. Cell phone to cell phone or landline to landline is pretty basic, but did you know you have to dial different numbers if calling a landline from a cell phone? Or different again from a cell phone to landline? Did you know that Jocotepec and San Juan Cosala are long distance area codes? Let's keep it simple with these guides.

AAA = Area Code
 MXN = local Mexican phone number

From Mexican cell to

| MXN cell | MXN landline | US/CDN cell or landline |
|-----------------|--------------------------|--------------------------------|
| 10-digit cell # | AAA + 7-digit landline # | 001 + AAA + 7-digit landline # |

From Mexican landline to

| MXN cell | MXN landline | US/CDN cell or landline |
|-----------------------|--------------------|--------------------------------|
| 045 + 10-digit cell # | 7-digit landline # | 001 + AAA + 7-digit landline # |

From US/CDN cell or landline to

| MXN cell | MXN landline | US/CDN cell or landline |
|--------------------------------|-------------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| 011 + 52 + 1 + 10-digit cell # | 011 + 52 + 7-digit landline # | 1 + AAA + 7-digit cell or landline # |
